
Statement of Faith

- We believe the Bible is the Word of God, written by human authors under the supernatural guidance of the Holy Spirit. It is the supreme source of truth for Christian beliefs and living.
- We believe God is the Creator and Ruler of the universe. There is one God who exists eternally in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- We believe in Jesus Christ; that he is fully God and fully human; that he was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary; that he lived a sinless life; that He died in our place to bring us into a relationship with the God the Father through the cross. We believe in His miracles; in His bodily resurrection; in His ascension to the right hand of the Father; in His present rule as Head of the Church; and that He will one day return in victory to rule forever.
- We believe in the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is present in the world to make us aware of our need for Jesus. The Holy Spirit lives in every Christian from the moment of salvation and provides Christians with the power to live a fruitful Christian life. We seek to live under the control of the Holy Spirit daily.
- We believe heaven and hell are places of eternal existence. Those who have not placed their faith in Jesus will exist eternally separated from God by sin, and those who have placed their faith in Jesus will exist with God through forgiveness and salvation. To be eternally separated from God is hell. To be eternally with God is heaven.
- We believe all people everywhere are created in the image of God and someone for whom Jesus died. We believe Jesus wants believers to live in unity as a way of pointing to the dignity and worth with which God created us and find equality across racial, gender, and class differences.
